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Welcome to your live aboard on the MY Longimanus!

In order to make a holiday as comfortable and smooth as possible, it is always good to prepare the trip carefully. Therefore we will give you all the information necessary to your coming holiday.

Preparation:

- check your passport for validity (at least for 6 more months) and give your TO your passport number at least two weeks before departure
- Bring a medical attest, certification and logbook (at least 50 dives)
- You can rent dive gear on board, please book at least one week in advance
- Bring spare parts (like mask straps etc.) yourself
- It is compulsory to have an alternate air source, dive computer and SMB

Arrival in Egypt:

At the airport you will be picked up by one of the staff of our Barakuda Fleet team, holding a sign as following:



Transfer time:

From airport Hurghada to Safaga, about 45 minutes
From airport Hurghada to Marsa Ghalib, about 3 hours
From airport Marsa Alam to Marsa Ghalib, about 15 minutes

Check in:

At 6 pm the boat will be ready for the new guests and the crew will welcome you with a cocktail. At 8 pm your first dinner on board will be served. In case you arrive early, we will bring you to a hotel near the harbour where you will meet your dive guide. Your luggage will be brought to the boat while you can relax at the swimming pool.



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Aboard:

Between 6 pm and 8 pm you will have enough time to unpack your bags and prepare your dive gear in the box that will be allocated to you. You can leave empty suitcases on the dive deck; the crew will put them away for the trip. The dive guide will hand you an information sheet and after dinner he will give you a clear briefing about the diving, rules on the boat and security matters. Have your return ticket on hand (with departure time and number of flight) so we can make sure that your transfer at the departure day will go smoothly.

In your cabin you will find a towel and a bathrobe. The towel will be changed halfway the trip.

If you want you can bring DVDs and CDs for the evenings.

Diving:

The next morning we will start the diving! Long distances between dive sites will be done at night (as much as possible) so we will not miss out on any dive. We will bring you by zodiac to drift dives and to dive sites where the boat cannot be moored. A live aboard is only meant for experienced divers (50 dives min.) as the divers are supposed **to dive independently in buddy-teams** after an extensive briefing about the dive site. Of course you are welcome to join the guide for some of your dives.

Food and Drinks:

Three times a day there will be a buffet in the salon. Breakfast consist of pita bread, toast, pancakes, marmalade, honey, nutella, cheese, eggs prepared in different ways, yoghurt, nescafe, tea and fruit juices.

The main meals consist of chicken, beef or fish, rice, pasta or potatoes and several kinds of vegetables and salads. At dinner time there will also be soup as a first course and a desert in the form of pudding, cakes or fruit.

Before the early morning dive and at teatime there will be cakes at your disposal.

Nescafe, tea, fruit juices and water are included in the price. You will have to note soft drinks (1,- €) beer (2,-€) and wine (15,- € per bottle) on a list at the bar and will have to be paid at the end of your trip (with an additional 10% VAT)

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Check-out:

The last night the boat will be in the harbour. As some of the crew will leave the ship there, they will bid their official goodbye there. The guide will bring around an envelope in which you can put a tip for the crew. If you felt happy and safe with the crew, they will be pleased to receive a tip from you. This is not a fix amount but depends on your own wallet, the more the better ☺

If you want we can organize an evening trip to the nearest town to do some (souvenirs) shopping.

We will take care of the reconfirmation of your flight and the guide will give you the details of your transfer for the next day.

The next morning at 9 pm you will have to clear your cabin and the guide will come with you to a hotel near the harbour, where you can relax until it is time to go to the airport.

Payment:

The guide will prepare your bill at the last day which can only be paid **CASH** in Euros, Dollars, Egyptian or English pounds according to the actual rate.

We have to add a 10%VAT on all extra costs (as nitrox, soft drinks, alcohol, shop and gear rental) which we have to pass directly to the Egyptian government.

We are already looking forward diving with you and from here we wish you a wonderful and unforgettable liveaboard!
